BSC announcements:

- BSC Challenge
 - This is a new event created by the BSC to get more Scouts Units to do joint activities with other Scout Units

 4 and send a photo to the BSC Executive
 - The prize is \$200 worth of vouchers from an outdoor camping store, to be shared by the winning Units and announced at Summer Camp 2024
 - o BSC Executive will select the winner, based on:
 - Number of Units, at least two but more points for 3+ Units
 - How fun the activity looked
 - How creative it was out of the box, unusual, etc
 - Working together and making friends
 - Demonstrating Scouting skills and values
 - Most likes on social media

- You don't have to include all these elements, but the more you do the more points you can earn
- Rules:
 - Only open to Scout Units
 - Activity must happen during Term 4, 2023
 - At least a third of the Scouts participating must come from another
 Unit
 - Activity must be with Scouts from another Unit AND another Group
 - Photo must be able to be posted online please check permissions with all youth members
 - Can't be an annual, major event (e.g. TriLakes, JOTA-JOTI, PACT)

Scouts ACT website refresh project

- Andrew from the IT Committee talked about his project to update the Scouts ACT website
- Mentioned that all the other websites are outdated so this is a new website featuring a bunch of new things
- BSC might have their own page
- The BSC suggested:

- Photo slides on main page (not really old ones and are updated regularly)
- Something to help recruit new Scouts to the Groups that need them so that Group gets more Scouts.
- List of Groups and if they are full or want new members
- Move contacts for activities providers (AA) to public site so we can see them
- A new BSC page and menu option to get there! This is to include the next meeting: where and when, plus notes (minutes) from the last meeting.
- A shared list of program activities that are run so Unit Councils can get inspiration and people can add to.
- o Set (or choose) your own colour theme for the website
- Recipes that Scouts have tried
- Be able to access their group's emails so we can contact them
- Videos of interviews with Scouts about how a recent activity went
- Fundraising ideas page (including events that need funds and how much)
 - GG's Camp
 - Summer Camp
 - Scout Groups (some don't have much money due to the small number of Scout members)
- Donations page
 - Allow people to make tax-deductible donations to Scouts ACT and
 - If they want to, identify a particular Group to help might (not necessarily to get all the money donated, but a good slice)
 - Identify Groups or activities that are looking for funding and what the money is for
- Event Page with coming and maybe past events on it, must include a contact for coming events
- Make the website mobile compatible BSC said it was hard to use on their mobile phones.

Summer Camp:

- Being planned for 12-18 January 2024

- Went through the proposed activity schedule, including onsite and offsite rotations and night activities
 - o The BSC sent their activity ideas from the July meeting to Maddie
- Market Day
 - The BSC supported the idea of a Market Day, where Patrols/Units would set up stalls to sell goods or services to make the more money
 - o Each Scout given a certain amount of 'Summer Camp' dollars to spend
 - The BSC Executive are interested in designing the 'Summer Camp' dollars

 - It could include details about the next days events, interesting stories and photos
 - Have a QR code or suggestions box for Scouts to submit stories and letters to the editor
