Welcome and introductions

Unit updates:

- All Units are doing fine, some concerns in terms of things the Council can't really help with
- 13th Canberra going well, 25-30 Scouts. Fun trips, ski trips, summer camp in Ulladulla
- Garran has lots of new Scouts, needs more Leaders
- Les Ex has a hike this weekend and a camp this term, needs more Leaders in Joeys and Cubs
- LBG Tasman had a camp last weekend at Wee Jasper, all going good
- LBG Trident is all going good, at this time of year less Cubs moving up
- Mt Majura has is a big age gap now. No big issues, ASA and ski trips happening
- Mt Taylor has young Scouts as the majority of experienced Scouts have moved up.
 Otherwise going well, excited for GG camp, ASAs coming up

- Units talked about doing more joint activities:
 - Les Ex and LBGSS Tasman looking at a joint activity
 - o Garran wants more inter-unit activities
 - Mt Taylor wants to camp with other Units at the GG Camp

Governor-General's Camp:

- September 24 29th (about 100 days away, or three months)
 - Has been rescheduled to 14-19 April
- Participation encouraged
- \$750 for Youth and \$250 for Leaders 10% deposit upfront when you register
- Can accommodate 3,000+ scouts, expecting 1,000
- BSC could help raise attendance rate, or organise fundraising for Scouts without the facilities/finances to go
- Camping Unit of 40 people (6 patrols x6 + 4 leaders)
 - o ACT Units can come together for one campsite or maybe two
 - o If people know other Groups from different states they could camp together
 - Units need to bring their own gear
- Will form groups for activities, which are 4-6 patrols (called Activity Units)
- Etiquette no drugs/vaping/smoking will be permitted

- The camp is five days and will have many different activities like:
 - Sailing
 - Walking
 - Paddling
 - Horse Riding
 - o Golf
 - 4 wheel driving
 - Rock climbing
 - Abseiling
 - o The list goes on!
- Different menus of activities so people can pick and choose what activities they want to do
- The camp will help people to sign off on badges
- There will also be some of the local and federal politicians because Parliament is sitting
- There might also be some bands playing at the stage
- Lots of interesting people who used to be Scouts will attend as guests
- Lastly you should talk to your Unit about who's going and the equipment you need and how you are going to transport it

- ACT will fly there (over 27 hour bus trip)
