

6.1 STRUCTURE OF SCOUTS ACT – SUPPORT FOR SCOUT GROUPS, ROVER CREWS AND FELLOWSHIPS

1. Scouts Australia Policy and Rules, R3, sets out that “Branches shall arrange support for Groups. A Scout District, as provided for below, normally carries this out”. In the ACT, these support functions are carried out by the appropriate Region Support Team.
2. This Policy includes Rover Crews and Fellowships as they are formations in their own right, in the same way as a Scout Group.
3. The Structure of Scouts ACT is set out in the following tables. The Chief Commissioner’s Directive provides details of the uniformed support structure.
